Many of the hand-dyed skeins are unique, one-off colourways so your knitted or crocheted item will also be a unique, one-off creation.

Skein Queen has packed boxes full of her trademark yarn on tempting yarn bases including a beautiful Corriedale/Polwarth yarn spun in the UK and put up in 200g skeins, perfect for garment knitting. She will also be bringing merino singles, silk blends, sock yarn and a stunning blend of baby alpaca, silk and cashmere.

Debbie's greatest wish is that Skein Queen yarn gives you a little frisson of excitement about the projects you want to create.
